First Report of the Oshawa Accessibility Advisory Committee (CS-19-11)

The Oshawa Accessibility Advisory Committee respectfully reports and recommends to the Community Services Committee its First Report.

1. Crossing Guards and Community Safety Zones (OAAC-18-60)

Recommendation

That staff review the following information:

1. The allocation of crossing guards at schools; and,

- 2. The establishment of community safety zones at schools; and,
- 3. The reduction of road speeds to increase pedestrian safety in Oshawa.

2. <u>Street Signage Standards</u>

(OAAC-19-03)

Recommendation

- 1. That the standards for street name signs including heritage, new subdivisions and decorative signs be increased in size; and,
- 2. That a larger, more consistent font size of 6 inches for major roads and 4 inches for local roads be implemented; and,
- 3. That colours be used to maximize contrast; and,
- 4. That the placement height of signs be considered so as to ensure they are reflected in vehicle headlights; and,
- 5. That all signs be positioned for visibility purposes.

Receipt of Automated External Defibrillator (A.E.D.) Donation from Safe Communities of Pickering and Ajax (SCOPA)

Recommendation

That the Community Services Committee recommend to City Council:

Whereas the City operates and maintains A.E.D.s with Lakeridge Health as part of the Public Access Defibrillator (P.A.D.) program since 2004; and,

Whereas since this time the City has continued to grow and expand the P.A.D. program with increasing availability of A.E.D. units at City facility locations; and,

Whereas City Recreational Facilities currently contain A.E.D.s at Civic Recreation Complex, Delpark Homes Centre, Donevan Recreation Complex, Northview Community Centre, South Oshawa Community Centre; and,

Whereas Safe Communities of Pickering and Ajax (SCOPA) has generously donated three mobile A.E.D. units to the City through Lakeridge Health; and,

Whereas these units are to be placed at Rotary Park Pool, Camp Samac Pool and Lakeridge Park Beach in conjunction with summer aquatic operations; and,

Whereas receipt of these units requires the City to execute a Defibrillator Transfer Agreement provided by SCOPA; and,

Whereas this agreement has been attached as Schedule A to this motion,

Therefore be it resolved that City Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute the agreement with SCOPA acceptable to Legal Services and Finance Services to receive the A.E.D.s.
