RE: Request for Committee of Adjustments Agendas and Minutes be searchable on City website

In my opinion the City of Oshawa is remiss in not making the Committee of Adjustment agendas and minutes available to the public on the City's website.

Although the City is obligated to notify owners of land in proximity when applications are made to the committee, and the City places a sign on a particular property describing what the application is and when it will be considered, often the sign is too small or poorly position, or traffic too busy for the public to see it.

In the interests of an open and transparent public process I am asking that the City of Oshawa post all future Committee of Adjustment agendas and minutes on the City's website and include the C of A scheduled meetings with the committee meetings on the City's Regular Meeting Schedule calendar.

Please note other municipalities such as Toronto and Peterborough make their Committee of Adjustment information available online.
