Pleased be advised that we, me and John Mappin, are interested in establishing a grave marker for the horse, Lady Angela to be located in the Trillium Woods on the property that was once Windfields Farm.

For the creation of marker we have met with the Oshawa Monument Company in Courtice as they created the markers for Northern Dancer and Vice Regent

The dimensions and composition of the marker will be similar to that of Vice Regent (attached photo)

other details:	Lady Angela
	1944 - 1966
	Hyperion                      Sister Sarah

location: approximately 3 feet to the south of marker for Chop Chop

finance: John Mappin has agreed to pay for the marker

why: Lady Angela is likely the most important horse buried on the farm

She is the dam of Nearctic, granddam of Northern Dancer

Hence matriarch of a vast dynasty of champion horses that continue to dominate horse racing the world over

The plan to honour Lady Angela was imitated by John's mother, the late Judith Mappin.

Sadly she passed away before we could install the marker. We simply hope to fulfill her

Hello Muriel and John,

Thank you again for coming in to meet with me to discuss the possibility of placing a marker in the Trillium Horse Cemetery to mark the grave of Lady Angela.

The Trillium Horse Cemetery was designated by by-law (By-law 65-2015) as being a property of cultural heritage value or interest. As such, in accordance with Section 33 of the Ontario Heritage Act any proposed alterations to the property that may impact the heritage attributes as defined in the by-law, must be consented to by Council in consultation with its municipal heritage committee (Heritage Oshawa).

The following summarizes our next steps in the process towards making the marker a reality:

1. M Kish to forward a copy of the Trillium cemetery survey to M Lennox and J Mappin (see attached survey excerpt);
2. Lennox/Mappin to send M Kish the proposal to place a marker for Lady Angela in Trillium Cemetery including a copy of the proof with text, material and dimensions and the survey indicating the location of proposed marker no later than November 18, 2015 (in order to be included on the November 22, 2015 Heritage Oshawa agenda. Otherwise it can go to a subsequent meeting). The proposal should indicate that you are proposing to pay for the cost of the marker;
3. M Kish to contact Tribute Communities (owner) to solicit permission to install grave marker;
4. November 26, 2015: subject to Tribute's permission, Heritage Oshawa to consider proposal;
5. December 7, 2015: Development Services Committee to consider resolution of Heritage Oshawa;
6. December 14, 2015: Council to consider resolution of Development Services Committee;
7. Subject to Council's endorsement of the proposal, Lennox/Mappin to commission monument maker to fabricate marker and coordinate installation with Tribute Communities.

I hope the above adequately summarizes the process.

I look forward to receiving your proposal with the accompanying details.
